

Levy, Natham, Rochester N. Y. Entered service in company H. Tenth Infantry at organization as SECOND Lieutenant OCT. 4, 1861 at DETROIT, for three years age 24.

Commissioned to date OCT 1, 1861

Mustered Feb. 6, 1862.

Commissioned FIRST Lieutenant, company I, April 26 1863

Mustered Aug 2 1863

Resigned and honorably discharged, January 12, 1864.

The service of the 10th Infantry commenced in Nov. 1861 by the appointment of its field officers; Company H includes Nathan Levy Second Lieutenant Rochester N. Y. 10th Regiment volume shows enlistment made at Detroit

The 10 left the State April 22 1862 for Pittsburg Landing MISS. was assigned to Gen Pope's Division, Army of the Mississippi then stationed at Farmington, in front of CORINTH. Seige of Corinth May 10-31 1862 Battles recorded following Corinth--- Boonville Miss. June 1 1862 Nashville Tenn. Nov. 5 Stone River Dec. Dec 29-31 1862 - Jan , ' 1863

1863, Laverge Tenn. Antioch April 1863

Nathan Levy commissioned FIRST Lieut. in company I Apr. 26 1863

The service of the 10 regiment continued in Tenn and Ga. the last engagement in 1863 - RINGGOLD TENN. Nov 27 1863.

The service record of Nathan Levy gives-- Resigned and honorably discharged Jan 12 1864; It is not possible to state he as First Lieut. of company I 10th Infantry, participated in this. *probably did.*

No record of return to Michigan in 1864.

Fairbanks Post # 17 organizes at Detroit May 9, 1881 - a careful check of both Post and Census of living veterans in Michigan through 1894 - find NO record of Nathan Levy. 2,536 recorded in Wayne county.

If ever a member of a Michigan Grand Army of the Republic Post, would show record as given when mustering and thru the years his Post service & memo of Civic activities of interest.

Any Post file will be checked; if name of Post not known the location will determine the number.
