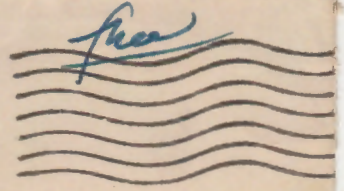
If I keep up this way you'll think that I'm so satisfied that I don't care if I never go back to Wilm, but don't get me wrong, there is no place I'd rather be anytime.
