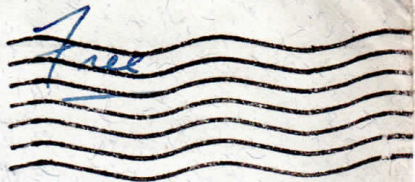
I'm feeling frightfully healthy and if they keep this up I'll have to go over and stop this war before my pants get too tight and choke me.
